



## SCA Funding 2020-21

*SCA available to Clifton Diocese £1,714,217*

This year the department received 71 bids for funding across the diocese, totalling £5,778,790.00.

Of those bids, 4 were for amounts in excess of £300,000.00; including one bid in excess of £700,000.00.

The bids consisted of:

- Roofing works
- Safeguarding
- Changing rooms
- Dining room extension
- Internal Lighting – LED upgrades
- Electrical wiring
- Drainage works – including replacement drains
- Kitchen upgrade
- External Lighting and Security Cameras
- Playground resurfacing
- Toilets
- Boiler Replacement
- Heating systems
- Hot water systems
- Fencing and security gates
- Sports cage fencing
- Asbestos removal
- New ceilings
- Flooring
- Roofing seals and guttering work
- DDA works
- Intervention Spaces
- Replacement tiles in Swimming Pool
- Replacement of windows
- Reconfiguration of Offices
- Fire Safety Systems

- Access control and lockdown system
- Site Accessibility

The Committee went through all the bids and looked at the PMS/CDC/AMP reports provided. They also took into account specialist reports and quotes where these were available.

The aim of the Committee was to ensure that those works that could potentially close a school (e.g. leaking roofs and failing heating systems) plus disability and safeguarding works were, as far as possible, addressed first.

Of the successful bids this year, many did not secure the full amount sought and projects were scaled back to ensure that the most urgent aspects could be addressed.

The Committee took account of the amount of DFC that schools had as well as the amount of DFC coming to schools this year. If a bid could be paid for out of the DFC available, then the expectation was that it should be. Generally, schools were also asked to pay 10% of their DFC towards their successful SCA bids to ensure that the SCA funding stretched as far as possible.

Schools who have had successful bids have been advised by email this week. If you have not had a letter, then I am afraid that your bid has not been successful.
