

Stations of Creation for Nursery

The reflection is based on the Stations of Creation which were inspired by the 'Canticle of the Sun' written by Saint Francis. There are two collective worships and a creation walk for you to do. Please adapt them in any way you wish. The reflection is in three parts:

Part 1 Collective Worship



This is based on the 'Canticle of the Sun,' a prayer Saint Francis wrote which praises the sun, moon, stars, wind, air, water and animals.

Part 2 Creation Walk



The children can go on a creation walk or use the slides. Show them the sky, earth, seas/water, air, plants and animals. Encourage the children to think of the importance of air, water and living things in our lives.

Part 3 Reflective moment



The children are asked how they can help Pope Francis care for the world. There are suggestions of how the children can help. The collective worship finishes with a prayer.

At the end of the power point is the hymn 'He's got the whole world in his hands' which in normal circumstances the children could sing. Maybe the children could dance to the recording of this instead.
