Service Level Agreement with Schools & Colleges - September 2023 – August 2024

All the Department's activities have cost implications, and these have been identified in formulating the Department's key Operating Objectives.

The services provided by the Department have been divided into:

- Core Services – those of benefit jointly to schools & colleges, and to the Bishop & Trustees;
- Additional Services – those primarily of benefit to individual schools & colleges.

The Core Services subscription in the Service Level Agreement secures a contribution from all schools/colleges towards the cost of providing services of joint benefit. The subscription for the 2023/24 academic year will be invoiced in September. A scale of charges for Additional Services is set out and these charges will apply throughout the period from 1 September 2023 to 31 August 2024. Schools/colleges will be invoiced individually for additional services following their delivery.
